á — Option + e, a

Á — Option + e, Shift + a

é — Option + e, e

É — Option + e, Shift + e

í — Option + e, i

Í — Option + e, Shift + i

ñ — Option + n, n

Ñ — Option + n, Shift + n

ó — Option + e, o

Ó — Option + e, Shift + o

ú — Option + e, u

Ú — Option + e, Shift + u

ü — Option + u, u

Ü — Option + u, Shift + u

To type Spanish punctuation, it necessary to press two or three keys at the same time. Here are the combinations to learn:

- Inverted question mark (¿) — Shift + Option + ?
- Inverted exclamation point (¡) — Option + 1
- Left angle quote («) — Option + \
- Right angle quote (») — Shift + Option + \
- Quotation dash (—) — Shift + Option + -
